SPONSORSHIP OPTIONS FOR PHARMACY TECHNICIAN EMPLOYERS AND EDUCATORS

WHAT IS SPONSORSHIP?

Sponsorship is a simple way for employers and educators to pay for pharmacy technicians to earn or renew PTCB CPhT Certification or CSPT Certification.

WHY BE A SPONSOR?

Sponsorship saves you time and offers a valuable benefit to your pharmacy technician employees or students. Plus, you avoid the hassle of cumbersome reimbursement paperwork by taking advantage of PTCB's online process. As a sponsor, you will receive access to PTCB's Sponsorship Portal to manage your pharmacy technician candidates, add and withdraw sponsorship, and create your own confidential reporting on pass/fail results for your sponsored test-takers.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

- Visit ptcb.org/sponsor to learn about sponsorship and apply.
- To become a sponsor, employers and educators first enroll in PTCB's free Employer Program or Educator Program.
- Once you are enrolled in either the Employer or Educator Program, your next step is to read and review the Sponsor Terms of Use Agreement found at ptcb.org/sponsor. After you have carefully reviewed this agreement, you may complete your Sponsorship Program Application.
- As soon as PTCB has approved your Sponsorship Program Application, you will receive information on how to log into the PTCB Sponsorship Portal. We can work with you to determine which method of sponsorship is best for you. All sponsors use PTCB's online sponsorship portal to manage candidates, add and withdraw sponsorship of candidates, and create reporting.

DO I PAY A FEE AS A SPONSOR?

Becoming a sponsor is free. The only cost you incur is the cost of sponsored candidates' exam or recertification fees.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

Sponsors enjoy a streamlined process for identifying eligible candidates using **one of five easy methods**.

- 1. Pre-approval:** This method is ideal for sponsors who have a pre-determined list of eligible candidates.
- 2. Vouchers:** This option allows sponsors to distribute vouchers to their eligible candidates.
- 3. Self-identification:** This method works well for those who may not know who is applying for certification from their organization.
- 4. IP Address Identification:** This option is ideal for sponsors whose candidates are applying from a particular computer network.
- 5. Token:** This method is best for sponsors who want to integrate their human resources or training network to an automatic application process that does not require approval of individual candidates.

HOW DO I PAY FOR MY SPONSORED CANDIDATES?

After you are enrolled, you will receive monthly invoices by email for your sponsored candidates who took the Pharmacy Technician Certification Exam (PTCE) or the Compounded Sterile Preparation Technician (CSPT) Exam and for CPhTs or CSPTs you sponsored for recertification during the previous month.
